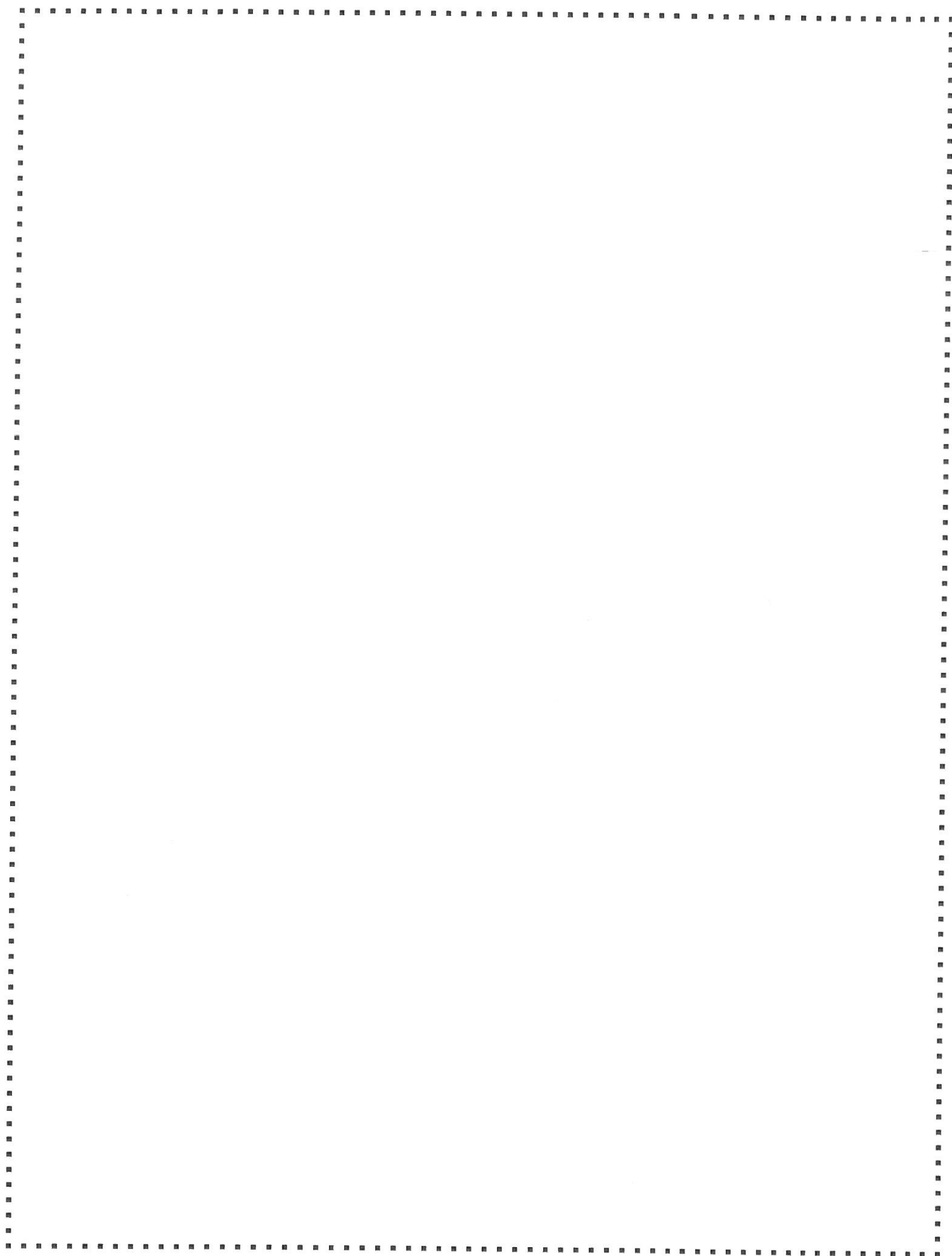
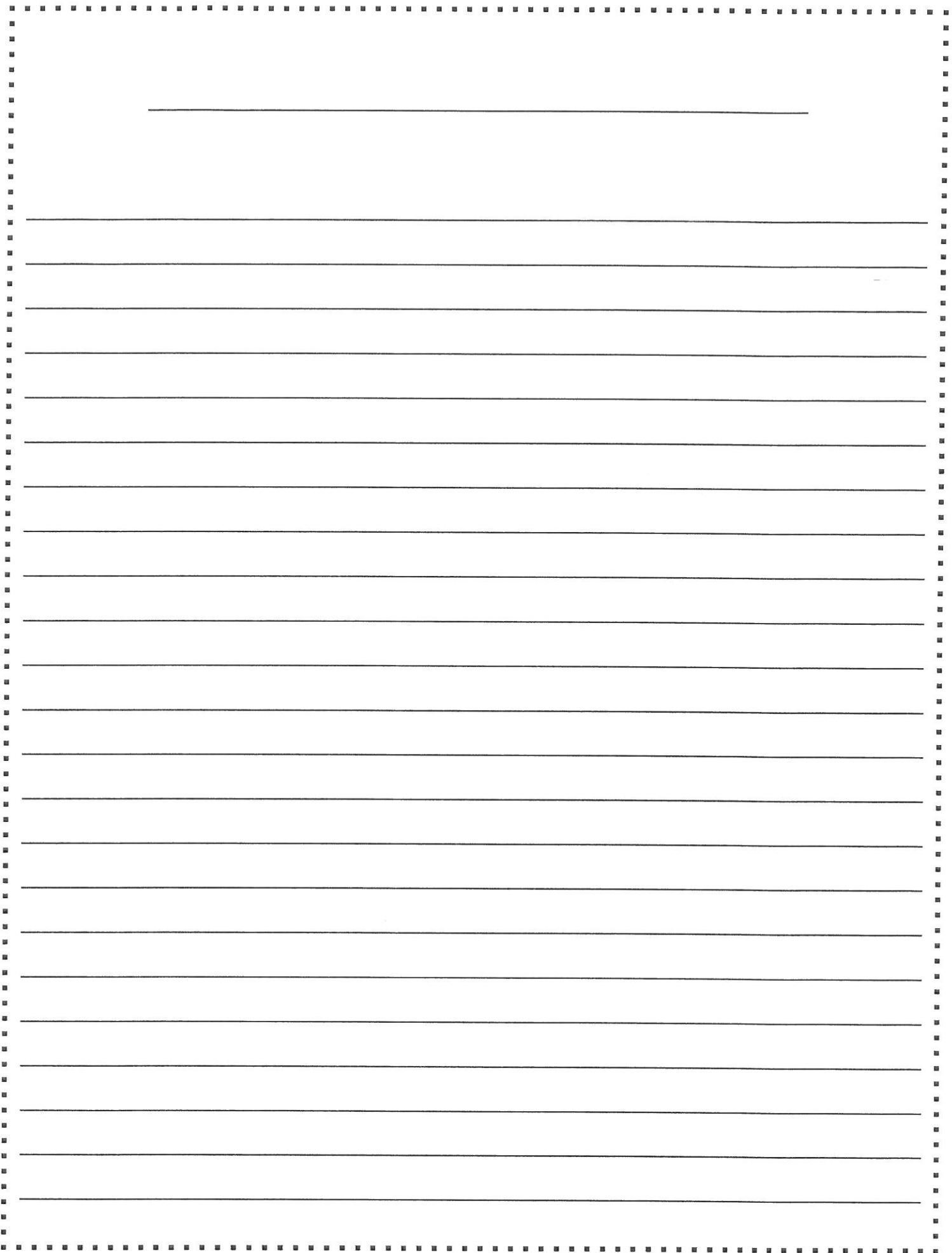

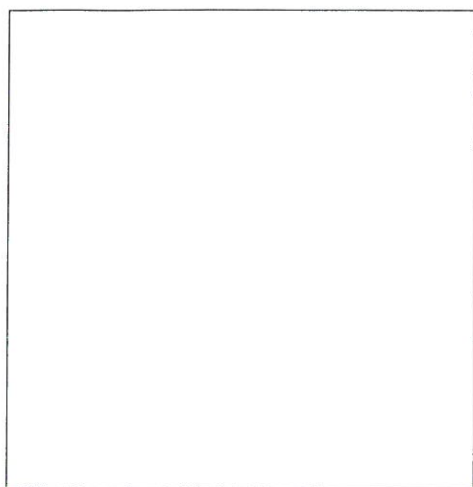
- Draft Paragraphs that include a topic sentence and supporting sentences followed by a concluding sentence
- Draft in Different Ways which could be cause/effect, pros & cons, or compare & contrast
- Research to gather interesting information from other sources
- Elaborate by including:
 - Partner sentences
 - Setting
 - Number, names, and examples
 - Physical descriptions
 - Quotes based on research
 - Define topic specific words
 - Use text features
- Use Transition Words to link information together

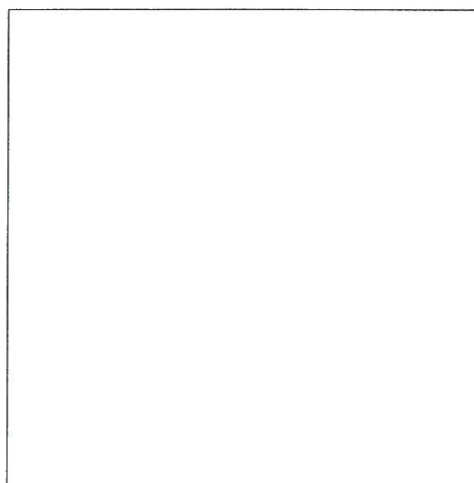
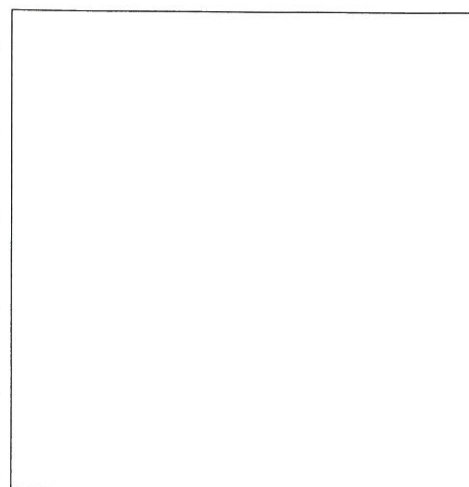
