<u>Notice & Name</u>	<u>Why?</u>
Picture/Photograph	To show reader the topic
Headings/Subtopics	To organize the paper
Partner Sentences	To explain, define words
Numbers, Names, Examples	To give the reader details, helps them understand
Quotes	To help the reader zoom in
Questions	To get the reader to focus
Introduction/Conclusion	Gets readers attention, at the end to remind
Transition words	To move the reader
Definitions, Bold Words, Vocab	To explain words
Hook	To get the reader interested
Intro, Body, Conclusion	To organize information
