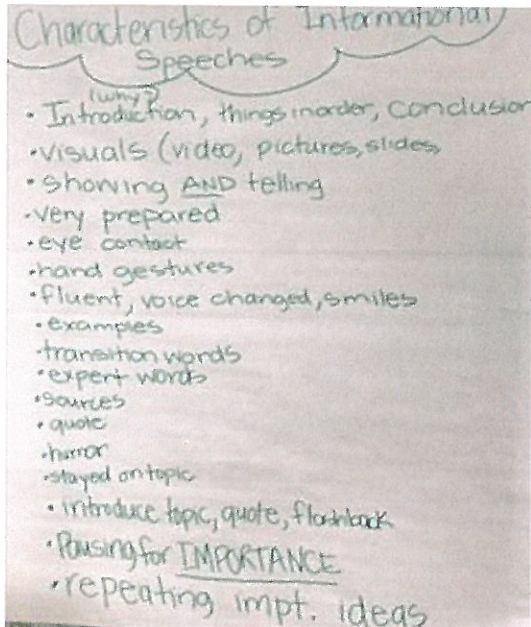

#### Characteristics Chart

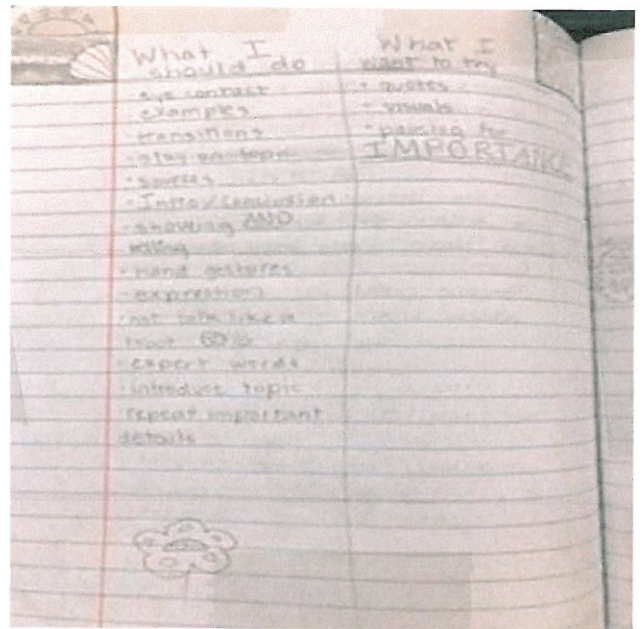
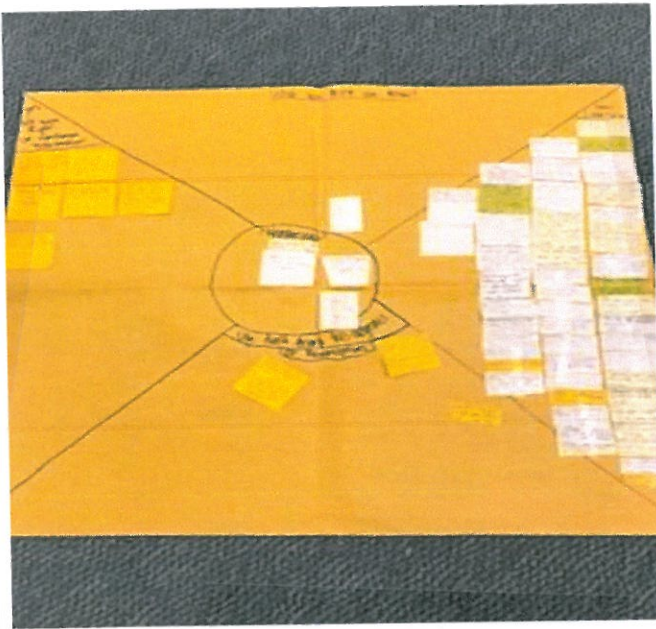


#### RAN Chart -Class
